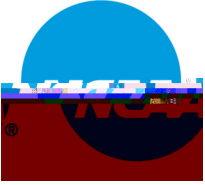

Introduction.

This information sheet on the NCAA Division I Graduation Rates Institution Report has been prepared by the NCAA, based on data provided by the institution in compliance with NCAA Bylaw 18.4.2.2.1 (Institutions and Graduation Rate Disclosure) in the federal Student Information Act. Please note, the NCAA will make this report public.

The Graduation Rates Institution Report provides graduation information about the most recent six-year graduation class of students in student-athletes who entered freshman in 2016-17. The graduation rate (percent) is based on a comparison of the number (N) of students who entered college or university in the number of those who graduate within six years. For example, if 100 students entered and 60 graduate within six years, the graduation rate is 60 percent.
